Library Services

The libraries provide information and instruction to every Monroe University student as a central element of the educational experience. The collections span the entire academic curriculum, including materials of interest within and outside the scope of courses. In addition to onsite resources and reference assistance, Monroe University offers students extensive online library and research tools and resources. The libraries provide access to print and electronic books and journals, databases, research guides, librarians, the Virtual Reference Desk, and other academic libraries (LYRASIS). Discovery for Monroe University is a search platform that simultaneously searches approximately 70% of the library's electronic resources.
