## NURSING, BS - ACCELERATED 2ND DEGREE INTERNATIONAL MEDICAL GRADUATE (IMG) OPTION

This Bachelor of Science degree, Nursing major option is designed for International Medical Graduates (IMGs) who have earned the equivalent of a bachelor's degree from an accredited non-U.S. medical school and are seeking a career change within health care. The total number of credits required for the degree is 121 (including 57 IMG transfer credits, 9 English credits, and 3 math credits, as required.) This program is an evening, weekend, and online program and is completed in 6 semesters. This program enrolls once per academic year in the spring semester.

## **Program Student Learning Outcomes**

Upon completion of the Bachelor of Science degree with a major in Nursing program, the graduate will be able to provide **Culturally Competent Care** with achievement of the following outcomes:
